QUESTION ON NOTICE

Cr McDonell requested that staff provide information on why the new footpath on Platinum Parade from William Maker Drive is being dug up or removed.

Cr Whitton asked what the works on Forest Road/Cadia Road were for.

The Director Technical Services advised there is communication work being done in the area. A fibre optic link to the new wind farm.

Cr Hamling asked about the vandalism that halted works on Clinton/Dalton Street roundabout.

The Director Technical Services advised that \$70k worth of damage to plant equipment was caused with every window smashed on the three items of plant on site. CCTV is now in place at this site.

Cr Mileto asked about the potholes being fixed along the new section of road from the airport to Spring Hill Road and being dangerous for cyclists.

The Director Technical Services advised there will be some works in front of the airport shortly, however it will not be the full stretch. Staff will continue to maintain the road surface by patching potholes for repair at this stage.

Cr Whitton asked if the C-130 doing touch and go's at the airport were required to pay for their use.

The Director Technical Services advised yes, fees are payable and that Defence conduct training regularly with various aircrafts not just with C-130's.

Cr Evans noted the airport passenger numbers and asked if it was possible to get a breakdown of major routes contributing to numbers.

The Director Technical Services advised that majority of traffic is from Sydney/Orange with two operators travelling the route with multiple services per day. This financial year is targeting 90,000 in passengers through our airport.
