# 5.10 SMALL DONATIONS AND GRANTS PROGRAM - DEFERRED AND OUT OF CYCLE APPLICATION

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This report provides information to Council to allow for the consideration of a resolution for funding through the Small Donations & Grants Program for one out-of-cycle request from Mountain Hope Church to cover the \$71 administration fee to book Margaret Stevenson Park, Spring St, Orange for three community BBQ events. This fee is charged under Councils adopted fees and charges.

Further information is also provided following questions taken on notice, for the request of \$3,000 from Mr Perfect to support the running of their monthly BBQs in support of men's health.

#### LINK TO DELIVERY/OPERATIONAL PLAN

The recommendation in this report relates to the Delivery/Operational Plan strategy "16.2. Support community organisations and groups to deliver services and programs".

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The budget for General Donations within the Small Donations & Grants Program for 2023/2024 is **\$84,000** with around \$21,000 set aside for each round of applications. So far **\$37,010** has been allocated from the fund.

The total amount recommended in this report is \$2,571 being \$2,500 of the \$3,000 requested by Mr Perfect (the maximum available in the category) and \$71 from Mountain Hope Church.

#### RECOMMENDATION

That Council resolves the following applications:

- 1 To donate \$2,500 (the category maximum) towards a request of \$3,000 from Mr Perfect to support the running of their monthly BBQs in support of men's health.
- 2 To donate \$71 to the Mountain Hope Church to pay for the administration fee to book Margaret Stevenson Park, Spring St, Orange for three community BBQ events.

#### **FURTHER CONSIDERATIONS**

Consideration has been given to the recommendation's impact on Council's service delivery; image and reputation; political; environmental; health and safety; employees; stakeholders and project management; and no further implications or risks have been identified.

#### SUPPORTING INFORMATION

At the Council Meeting of 5 September 2023, Council deferred consideration of application 1 for the purpose of obtaining additional information. Mr Perfect holds free community BBQ's once a month from 10.00am - 12.00pm on a Sunday morning. Local men of all creeds, backgrounds and ages are encouraged to come along, have a free sausage sandwich, get out in the sunshine, and have a chat and make a connection with other men from the local community.

On average, 35 to 50 men attend the monthly BBQs in Orange.

The BBQs offer a unique, non-clinical opportunity for men to meet and connect. Benefits include an increased sense of community felt by men and their families and increased mood, which can lead to better mental health outcomes.

How the funds are distributed over the year:

- Costs are split between food, marketing, insurance, and equipment.
- Most significant cost is the online marketing key to reaching their audience.
- Equipment for volunteers and hosts includes branded signage, BBQ tools, plates etc.
- Food includes sausages, salads, drinks, bread etc it is strictly an alcohol-free event.

The Orange event is hosted by the local State MP Philip Donato and Cr Glenn Floyd. The Office of Local Government have advised that they have no prohibition under the rules and regulations regarding Council funding this event, and that Mr Donato's state campaign was incidental and not a direct conflict. The OLG has stated that in this case, if the request is in line with Council Policy, Council has discretion to support if desired.

#### YOUR ORGANISATION

Please describe your organisation and its purpose

Mr Perfect has been operating in over 60 locations all across Australia for more than 5 years. In this time, we have had thousands of men turn up to our local Sunday morning BBQ's and find an easy way to make connections with other men, creating the opportunity to either give a hand, or possibly get some advice that could be crucial at that time. We know from our experience that men who participate and attend our BBQ's have an increased sense of community (felt by these men and their families) and increased mood which will lead to better mental health outcomes. We have also undertaken qualitative research by way of Survey Monkey surveys for the BBQ attendees to complete anonymously, asking them if attending a BBQ had improved their outlook and why. #### **REASON FOR APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

Our great Charity organisation runs on the smell of an oily rag. We are an organisation with 50 volunteers and a couple of internal adminisatrative staff paid nominal amounts.
