3.1 CURRENT WORKS

Cr Kinghorne asked what the optimal level of water storage is, and if there is any sort of flood mitigation usages for the Suma Park Dam and Spring Creek Dam, as the Macquarie Pipeline is not often utilised.

The Director Technical Services advised that both Spring Creek Dam and Suma Park Dam are licenced for water storage for town use and not for flood mitigation purposes. The goal is to keep the water storage level between 80-100%, which places less restrictions on water users. The reason the Macquarie Pipeline is not utilised often is that a condition of use of the Macquarie Pipeline is that Orange needs to be below 90% water storage.

Cr Kinghorne asked if there is a financial reason behind not utilising the Macquarie Pipeline often as Orange water storage levels have dropped below 90% during this year.

The Director Technical Services advised that Council has a decision support tool that looks at the forecasts going forward through the year and determines whether Council needs to operate those facilities. The Macquarie Pipeline is the most expensive source of water as it has to be pumped, and it was not deemed necessary as the medium range weather forecast was for near average to above average rainfalls that will see Suma Park Dam fill and spill in Spring 2025.

Cr Mallard requested asked what considerations have been made on providing assistance for people crossing the road at the Ploughman's Wetlands, such as pedestrian crossings or traffic calming infrastructure.

Cr Mallard asked for the annual total of the supplementary raw water sources for the 2024/2025 year to be included in the Current Works report as a comparison.

Cr Duffy asked if Council could write to UGL to install boom gates at the railway crossing at Woodward Street.

The Director Technical Services advised that Council has already written to UGL, who has promoted the issue with Transport for NSW which will now form part of their consideration for Federal funding submissions.
